

Oil Painting Supplies with Jerry Haworth

1. Paint: Cadmium Yellow Medium, Napthal Red, Phthalo Blue, White, Black. These are the basics. A Burnt Umber and Alizarin Crimson will be helpful.
2. Painting Mediums: Galkyd medium by Gamblin is for thinning and help drying. The small bottle would do. Or, any of the fine oil for thinning, they do take longer to dry.
3. Thinner: Get at least a quart of Mineral Spirits, (not "Paint Thinner", Should be labeled "Mineral Spirits") You will need at least three containers to clean brushes and mix mediums.
4. Pallet: Anything to mix your color on.
5. Rags: Cut up an old towel. They work best for brushes and cleaning.
6. Brushes: A 1 inch flat, 1/2 inch round and a detail brush
7. Canvas: At least 11x14 or larger. Canvas boards or pre stretched
