2B, 4B, 6B pencils
exacto knife
tortillions

Graphite Crayon
paper towels
stubs

ruler
triangle
masking tape

Q tips
Handi-wipes

Support board larger than your paper size / make it easy to carry w/ size & weight
It has to be a smooth surface. Bumps show in shading.

Soft brush (to sweep eraser crumbs off your paper) Example: artist's sweep or soft
makeup brush from the Dollar Store.

Erasers-kneaded and soft plastic (Steadler or Factic)

Sketchbook, mid-size to a maximum of 14 x 17. If you will be doing a very nice drawing
that you will be spending a lot of time on, choose some nice paper of 80lb. quality or
more in a Bristol or Vellum finish.

Reference from newspapers, magazines, and photos (choose your own subject) I will
bring some, but mine go home with me. You can take a picture of mine, make a copy
and for sure bring your own reference. Choose good light and shadow in your
reference. If you can't see it, you can't draw it.
